
FIBRE LED CABLE Installation instructions



These instructions assume the cable is to be fitted into a ceiling tile. In practice, it can be fitted in a variety of locations, e.g. a plasterboard wall, providing there is access to the rear of the board.



INSTALLATION

- 1. On the rear of the tile, mark the 30 positions for the fibre optic strands of the cable.
- 2. Drill 30 x 1mm holes in those positions.
- 3. Remove the protective outer sleeve from the cable to expose the fibre optic strands.
- 4. Feed each fibre optic strand through a 1mm hole, so it is protruding approx 5mm through the other side.
- Apply a small amount of adhesive (e.g. a drop of superglue) to secure each strand, and allow the glue to set. NOTE: Do not use hot melt glue.
- 6. Using sidecutters, trim the protruding fibre optic strands to approx 1mm in length.
- 7. Carefully fit the tile into the ceiling.
- 8. Refer to the LED unit instructions to install and wire the LED unit.
- 9. Fit the metallic end of the cable into the LED unit. Push down firmly to ensure it is fully seated.
